The regularization of the above employees shall be governed by the provisions of SRO-400 of 2009 dated 21.12.2009 issued by the Finance Department.

The appointees shall be on probation for a period of two years. Their seniority shall be determined by the Motor Vehicles Department on the basis of their date of regularization in their respective cadre.

The Motor Vehicles Department, where the appointees is presently working shall allow them to join formally on the post on which they have been regularized after checking the following certificates in original;-

- i. Date of Birth Certificates.
- ii. Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC).
- iii. Academic Qualification Certificate.
- iv. Technical Qualification (Where required)

If on verification, the certificates produced by the appointees proved fake or forged, the appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.


