1. Vide G.O No. 1564-GAD of 1997 dated 29.09.1997, issued by the General Administration Department, (Respondent No. 2), the petitioner No. 1, Sh. Anil Suri working in the Social Welfare Department as Junior Assistant was transferred to the office of Transport Commissioner (Respondent No.6) against an available vacancy. Similarly, the petitioner No. 2, Sh Rajiv Kumar, who was working as Jr. Assistant in Khadi and Village Industries Board (Respondent No: 8 herein) was transferred to the office of RTO Jammu (Respondent No: 7) against an available post vide G.O 186-GAD of 1994 dated 21.02.1994 issued by General Administration Department (Respondent No. 2). The aforesaid G.Os were issued in consultation with KVIB and Transport Department. Subsequently the Transport Commissioner vide its letter dated 7.09.2005 requested for repatriation of both the petitioners to their respective parent departments. The request of the Transport Commissioner was examined and considered by General Administration Department (Respondent No. 2) and vide G.O No: 1604-GAD of 2005 dated 27.12.2005 the petitioners (Sh. Anil Suri and Mr. Rajiv Kumar) were repatriated to their respective parent Departments, However, instead of joining back to their respective parent departments, the petitioners approached the Hon'ble court by way of writ petition No. 115/2006 and stayed the operation of Government Order No.1304-GAD of 2005 dated 27.12.2005 in terms of order of the Hon'ble Court dated 31.01.2006. In compliance to the said orders of Hon'ble Court, the petitioners (Shri. Anil Suri and Mr. Rajiv Kumar) were allowed to continue in the Transport Department (Motor Vehicles Department). In this regard, an order bearing No. 39/TC/Estt. Of 2006 dated 26-04-2006 was passed. The Hon'ble Court disposed of the writ petition SWP No. 115/2006 vide order dated 19-08-2017, operative part of which is reproduced as below:-

"Viewed thus, the order impugned whereby the petitioners have been repatriated to their parent departments cannot be found fault with which otherwise is in consonance with law governing the deputation and, therefore, cannot be interfered with. Consequently, the writ petition of the petitioners being devoid of any merit is dismissed. No order as to costs".

Since the petition was disposed in favour of State respondents, the
petitioners Sh. Anil Suri and Mr. Rajiv Kumar aggrieved of the same
challenged the writ court order by way of filing of LPA SW No.
149/2017, which came to be disposed of by Hon'ble Court Vide order

24-07-2018 with following directions:-

"in view of preceding analysis, we hereby quash the order passed by the learned Single Judge Insofar as it pertains to order passed in SWP No. 115/2006 and to direct the State Government to consider the case of the appellants for their continuation in the Motor Vehicles Department by invoking rule 5 of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and to accord the appellants all the consequential benefits. Let the aforesaid exercise be carried out within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order passed today. Till a decision is taken in this regard, the appellants shall be permitted to continue in the Motor Vehicle Department. With the aforesaid direction, the appeal is disposed off along with connected IA."

Whereas, Subordinate Services of Motor Vehicle Department is governed by the Jammu and Kashmir Transport Controllers (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 1974, and the said rules provides that no person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any class, category or grade in the service unless he possesses the qualification as laid down in schedule A and fulfills the requirements of recruitment provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force. For facility of reference, relevant portion of Rule 5, i.e., 5(1), 5(2) and 5(3) is reproduced hereunder:-

"5(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any class, category or grade in the service unless he possesses the qualification as laid down in Schedule 'A' and fulfill the requirements of recruitment provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.

5(2) Appointment to the service shall be made-

(a) By Direct recruitment;

(b) By promotion/selection;

(c) Partly by direct recruitment and partly by promotion/selection;
In the ratio and in the manner as indicated against each post in Schedule 'A'.

5(3) in case suitable candidates are not available for promotion/selection; the post shall be filled up by

direct recruitment and vice versa."

Whereas, from the perusal of the rules reproduced hereinabove, it is abundantly clear that initial recruitment to the Transport Controller's (subordinate) services can only be made either by direct recruitment or by promotion /Selection and the mode of recruitment by way of transfer is not provided.

Whereas, it was only in view of different court orders and directions the petitioners were continued in Motor Vehicle Department even after the lapse of statutory period of deputation.

Whereas, the member of service or class of service can be required to serve in any part of Jammu and Kashmir State in any post borne on the cadre of such service or class and therefore, any transfer outside the cadre or service is nothing but deputation as defined under Article 52-B of the J&K Civil Service Regulations, 1956.

Whereas, the termination of lien of both the appellants/officials was never confirmed by the Transport Department (Motor Vehicles Department) which is a prerequisite condition laid down under Article 37-C of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956 for the termination of lien of a Government Servant on his transfer to a post outside his cadre.

Whereas, the lien of Government Servant on a post may in no circumstances be terminated even, with his consent, if the result will be to leave him without a lien.

Whereas, the case of the appellants/petitioners has been examined in compliance with the order of Hon'ble High Court, dated 24-07-2018, and it has been found that the claim of the petitioners for their absorption in Transport Department (Motor Vehicles Department) is devoid of merits and cannot be considered even in light of Rule 5 of the J&K Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 as initial recruitment to the Transport Controller's (subordinate) services can only be made either by direct recruitment or by promotion/Selection and the mode of recruitment by way of transfer is not provided, hence their claim is rejected. The appellants Sh. Anil Suri and Sh. Rajiv Kumar are repatriated from

Motor Vehicle Department to their parent Departments/organization with immediate effect. Accordingly, their respective head of offices namely Transport Commissioner, J&K and RTO (Jammu) shall relieve them immediately with directions to report to their parent department/Organization

Hon'ble Court while disposing of writ petition SWP No. 1501/2018 titled Hafiz-Ul-Rehman vs State of J&K and Anr. On 25-07-2018 passed detailed order the operative part of which is reproduced as under:-

"...Be that as it is, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondents to consider the grievance projected by the petitioner in this petition in the light of law declared by the Division Bench of this court in case of Afaq Rasool Gadda (supra) and pass appropriate order giving retrospective effect to the regularization of the petitioner from the date, it is found due in view of the law laid down in the aforesaid judgment."

Whereas, petitioner among the following were appointed on adhoc basis by the Transport Commissioner office for a period of 89 days by virtue of various orders as mentioned against each and their period of engagement were extended from time to time under different orders:

Whereas, the regularization of these officials were challenged in the Hon'ble High Court by different writ petitions and their services were terminated by the Transport Commissioner vide Order No. 61-65/TC/C dated 27-08-2003. Consequent upon the termination order, these officials approached Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP titled Manoj Nargotr and Ors. V/S State and Ors and Rajesh Jamwal V/S State and Ors. The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide judgment dated 16-09-2004 disposed off their petitions with several directions in which one of the direction is reproduced as under:-

"The appellants may be allowed to continue in service till such regular recruitments are made and these posts are filled up by regular process of appointment."

Whereas, the matter was taken up with Department of Law Justice and Parliamentary affairs, who, in turn advised the Department that these officials shall be allowed to continue in the services. In the meantime, Transport Department vide communication No. TR-7/MVD/2004 dated 05-08-2005 referred these posts to the Service Selection Board for selection of suitable candidates which were advertised vide No. 03 of 2005 dared 18-08-2005. These officials again approached the Hon'ble High Court, J&K in case SWP No. 1333 of 2005 titled Manoj Nargotra and Ors. V/S State and Ors and the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 20-12-2006 stayed the operation of notification No. SSB/Div/J/2006/75625-33 dated 29-11-2006 issued by

Service Selection Board in pursuance of advertisement notice No. 3 of 2005 pertaining to the posts held by these officials.

Whereas, after the enactment of the Jammu and Kashmir, Civil Services (Special Provisions) Act, 2010, these officials approached the Department for regularization of their services in terms of the above said Act. Accordingly, their request was processed and the matter was referred to the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs for seeking legal opinion in the instant case. In response, the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs vide U.O. No. LD(Ser) 2013/161/TR dated 27-06-2013 opined that the cases of these officials be placed before Empowered Committee constituted under the said Act.

Whereas, in the mean time, these officials again approached Hon'ble High Court in SWP No. 1793/2013 titled Mubashir Hussain and Ors V/S State and Ors on the same subject wherein the Hon'ble High Court vide judgment dated 27-08-2013 directed the State respondent to accord consideration to petitioners claim Accordingly, on the basis of legal opinion of the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs dated 27-06-2013 and Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court dated 27-08-2013, the cases of these petitioners were referred to the Finance Department for placing before the Empowered Committee and in the 59th meeting of the Empowered Committee held o 30-05-2017, the same were cleared for regularization, subject to studying all pros and cons of the Court cases in consultation with Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs. Whereas, Department again approached the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs for their opinion regarding the recommendations recorded by Empowered Committee in the 59th meeting. In response, the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs vide U.O No. LD(Se)2013/61-TR dated 08-08-2017 advised to go ahead with the process of regularization for these employees subject to the condition that the department has to ensure that no court direction is restraining the Department to regularize the petitioners in any other writ petition.

Whereas, pursuant to the clearance conveyed by the Empowered Committee vide No. PS/DC/Misc-365/14 dated 20-09-2017, the department got verified their requisite documents viz, Qualifications Certificates, Date of Birth (DOB) Certificates and Permanent Resident Certificates (PRC's) from the concerned quarters through Transport Commissioner, J&K who submitted their verification report to the Department vide letter No. TC/JK/Estt/6796 dated 26-10-2017. Accordingly, regularization orders were issued in favour of

the above said consolidated employees vide Government Order No. 07-TR of 2018 dated 16-01-2018.

Whereas, as per the proviso to section 5 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Special Provisions) Act, 2010, the regularization of the eligible ad hoc or contractual or consolidated appointees under the Act shall have effect only from the date of their regularization, irrespective of the fact that such appointees have completed more than seven years of service on the appointed date or thereafter but before such regularization.

Now, therefore the case of the petitioners has been examined and considered in compliance of the order dated:- 25.07.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court vis-à-vis the rules governing the subject matter, it has been found that the claim of the petitioner being devoid of merits, hence rejected.
