Government Order No. 31-JK (TR) of 2020
Dated: 22-06-2020

Sanction is hereby accorded to the charging of 130% of the existing authorized fare (existing authorized fare+30% of the existing authorized fare) from the passengers by stage carriage passenger vehicles, till further orders or till the restrictions imposed on the seating capacity, in view of COVID-19 pandemic, are eased, whichever is earlier and following which, only the authorized fare shall be charged from the passengers.

This issues with the concurrence of Chairperson, State Executive Committee under the Disaster Management Act, 2005.
