Now, therefore, in view of the facts elucidated above and with the approval of competent authority, sanction is hereby accorded to the reinstatement of Shri Romesh Kumar Samotra, I/c ARTO in consonance with the provisions of the rule-31 (3) of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956, subject to following conditions:-

i) He shall immediately join as I/c ARTO, Kishtwar, as ordered vide Government Order No. 35-JK(TR) of 2020 dated: 27-07-2020, relieving I/c ARTO, Doda of the additional charge of the post.
