Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of funds amounting to **Rs.760.60 lakh (Rs. Seven crore sixty lakh and sixty thousand only)** and its advance drawl by Director Finance, Transport Department under Major Head:2041, Detailed Head:028-Grant in Aid, for further placement at the disposal of Transport Commissioner J&K for its utilization for implementing the following component wise activities for the year 2022-23 for Road Safety measures:-

2	Purchase of 36 Nos of Breath Alcohol Analyzers	₹17.30

4	Imparting one day Basic Life Support Training to the police personnel	₹6.30
5	Administrative expenses for Lead Agency	₹10.00
6	Rectification of Black Spots by way of installing Crash Barriers, Sign Boards/Parapets, Night Reflectors etc in Jammu Division	₹500.00
7	Hire 20 No of vehicles for the RTOs/ARTOs to carry out enforcement activity	₹100.00
	Total funds required	₹760.60 lakhs

However, the Funds so drawn in advance and placed at the disposal of Transport Commissioner for its further utilization subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Transport Commissioner/Concerned DDO shall vouchsafe the Availability of funds as per codal provisions.


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2. The HoD concerned/DDO shall utilize the fund after ensuring strict compliance of all due procedures as prescribed under GFR and Manual of procurement of Goods and Services.
3. The HoD concerned/DDO shall make the procurements after following due bidding procedure on GeM Portal.
4. The amount shall be utilized for implementing component wise activities of the Approved Action Plan and shall not be parked unnecessarily in the Bank Account.
5. The HoD concerned shall ensure the completion of proposed projects ensuring Road Safety Measures within a time frame of three months.
6. Transport Commissioner shall further place the funds at the disposal of concerned HoDs for its utilization as per items approved in the Action Plan.
7. Transport Commissioner shall coordinate with all concerned HoDs for successful implementation of the approved items of the action plan and furnishing of Red Account to the Administrative Department/Accountant General within prescribed time.
8. The HoD concerned/DDO shall complete these works within three months failing which funds may be deemed to have been withdrawn and should be returned.
